Dear Judge Suiter:

We have reviewed your application for a municipal solid waste permit modification dated July 5, 2017, requesting changes to the existing site development plan for the above referenced facility to authorize landfill gas management plan.

Our review indicates that insufficient information has been provided to demonstrate compliance with Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC) §305.70. Therefore, we are unable to complete the processing of your request. Please review and address the following comments:

1. The application is not posted at the URL address entered in Section 5, form TCEQ-20650. Please provide the correct URL address where the application is posted.
2. Please include all mineral interest ownership under the facility or a statement indicating that there is no mineral interest ownership.
3. Please include all installed gas probes in Figure GMP-A-5, Appendix A.
4. The landfill gas monitoring remediation effective report dated June 18, 2017 indicates methane concentration levels recorded in three perimeter probes, GMP-1, GMP-4, and GMP-6, were still above the regulatory compliance limit. New extraction wells are proposed to be constructed to further mitigate exceedances at GMP-4 and GMP-6. Please explain how exceedance at GMP-1 will be addressed.

Please revise your permit modification request and submit the revisions within 30 days from the date of this letter or the request may be considered withdrawn. To facilitate our review:

- Ensure that each revised page has a header or footer that indicates the revision number and date in accordance with 30 TAC §330.57(g)(6);
- Provide revised and/or additional pages in a form suitable for replacement and/or inclusion in the initial permit modification application and a new certification statement that includes the name, title, address, and signature of the responsible official, in accordance with 30 TAC §305.44;
- Include the Tracking No.(s) in reference line above in the subject line of the response and submit one original, two unmarked copies, and one marked copy (for example, in redline/strikeout format) of the revisions in conformance with 30 TAC §305.70(f). One of the unmarked copies should be sent directly to the TCEQ Region 10 Office, to the attention of the Waste Section Manager, 3870 Eastex Fwy, Beaumont, Texas 77703; and

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- Post any revisions to the application to a public website in accordance with 30 TAC §330.57(i)(1), if applicable to your application.

Failure to submit a satisfactory response to the item(s) listed above may result in a recommendation to deny this modification request.
