- The Judge and Clerks are prohibited from providing legal advice or assisting in filling out forms.
- A copy of the New Rules for Civil Procedure and the Texas Property Code are provided in our office for your review. You may also access these documents on our website.
- You must provide the court with the original, a copy for your records, and 1 copy per defendant (if 2 defendants will be served, then you must provide a copy for each of them) of all documents filed with the court.
- You cannot discuss your case with the Judge outside of the hearing.
- We accept filings Monday thru Friday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm
- We do NOT serve Out of County Citations. Please notify the clerk so you are not charged for service on an Out of County Citation.
- If your suit is settled out of court and you no longer wish to come to your hearing, please file it in writing with the Court. You may use the form for Non Suit located on our website if you wish.

The claim can be for no more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.		<input type="checkbox"/> Eviction: An eviction case is a lawsuit brought to recover possession of real property, often by a landlord against a tenant. A claim for rent may be joined with an eviction case if the amount of rent due and unpaid is not more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.
<input type="checkbox"/> Repair and Remedy: A repair and remedy case is a lawsuit filed by a residential tenant under Chapter 92, Subchapter B of the Texas Property Code to enforce the landlord's duty to repair or remedy a condition materially affecting the physical health or safety of an ordinary tenant. The relief sought can be for no more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.		<input type="checkbox"/> Small Claims: A small claims case is a lawsuit brought for the recovery of money damages, civil penalties, personal property, or other relief allowed by law. The claim can be for no more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.
