## Cassels-Boykin Pavilion (CBP) Regulations

- 1. Payment must be made in full by day before event.
- 2. All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas only. ABSOLUTLY NO vehicles allowed under the pavilion unless approved by CBP officials.
- 3. Skateboards, skates and rollerblades are prohibited from the pavilion area.
- 4. No cooking is allowed under the pavilion.
- 5. Discharge of any waste water, gray water or cooking fluids/oils on CBP grounds is prohibited. All fish/crawfish refuse and water discharges must be contained in portable holding tanks and disposed of properly off CBP grounds. (monitored)
- 6. Pavilion and parking area must be kept clean at all times with all trash picked up and deposited in trash dumpster prior to leaving park (monitored).
- 7. Angelina County and CBP will not be responsible for damages to property or injuries to person/s which are incidental to the approved event.
- 8. Admission and participation in events will be open to the general public without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age.
- 9. Parking and crowd control must be strictly supervised to insure public safety during and immediately following events.
- 10. The CBP grounds and shoreline must be cleaned of all event refuse within 12 hrs after the event or an additional \$250 trash pickup fee will be charged to the renter.
- 11. All fishing tournaments must comply with federal and Texas Parks and Wildlife boating and fishing laws- Including consumption or release of fish during the event.
- 12. We will notify Texas Parks and Wildlife, U.S. Forest Service and local law enforcement agencies of the event prior to event date.
- 13. Fishing tournament directors must notify their participants of boat launch fee requirements on Sam Rayburn Reservoir- \$5.00.
- 14. Alcohol at all events must be approved under the TABC laws.
- 15. Security must be provided by event organizer during the event if alcohol is provided. (This security must be arranged through the Angelina County Sheriffs Dept.)
- 16. The sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in the park. Intoxicated persons will not be allowed into the park and visitors who become intoxicated will be removed.
- 17. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at youth events.
- 18. CBP restrooms are limited for use to 250 participants/spectators- (1) portable toilet for every 100 people over the 250 max is required.
- 19. No tent or banner stakes allowed without prior permission from the park director.
- 20. No soliciting is allowed. No one may rent or sell an item or service except under an approved concession agreement.
- 21. Noise limit- All amplified music must be turned off between the hours of 10pm and 7am. (If having a band or DJ for wedding reception please let booking agent or park director know and exceptions may be made)
