Dear Mr. Fitzgerald:

The Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Permits Section has finalized RG-420, Guide for Preparing Site Operating Plans for Municipal Solid Waste Facilities. The purpose of this letter is to notify you that in accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §330.111, effective the date of this letter, you are required to submit a permit modification in accordance with 30 TAC §305.70(1) with notice to incorporate the requirements as necessary into your current Site Operating Plan.

Please submit an original and three (3) copies of your modification request within 60 days of the date of this letter. Your response must be in a form that allows for the replacement of current permit application pages with the revised pages or alternatively an entirely new Site Operating Plan (SOP). If a new SOP is being provided, revision or deletion of existing SOP provisions other than those required to comply with the update to Subchapter F, must be identified with an explanation of the proposed change in accordance with §305.70(e). According to 30 TAC §330.51(e)(4), revisions must have a revision date and note that the sheet is revised in the header or footer of each revised sheet or page and the revised text must be marked to highlight the revision.

Failure to submit a timely response to this call-in notice may result in the requirement that the permittee submit a major amendment in accordance with Chapter 305 Subchapter D in order to become compliant with 30 TAC §330.111.
