NOTICE

Read over your paperwork carefully and complete all forms included in the packet. If you fail to provide ALL of the information required, the case may be dismissed. It is best to have an Attorney, but if you choose to represent yourself, you are responsible for your case. **Refer to the Self Help Resources for assistance.**

Effective January 1, 2022, Justice Court Civil Filing Fee has increased to **\$54.00**

- The Judge and Clerks are prohibited from providing legal advice or assisting in filling out forms.
- **Please refer to www.AngelinaCounty.net to access the County Maps link to determine the precinct/office you should file in and that office's hours of operation, hours they accept civil filings, and the methods of payment accepted.**
- If you are a Pro Se Litigant (Not represented by an Attorney), it is your responsibility to be familiar with the laws that govern Evictions. Copies of the **Texas Rules for Civil Procedure** (*Sec. 510 covers Evictions*) and the **Texas Property Code** (*Sec. 24 covers Forcible Detainers/Evictions. Sec. 24.005 covers Notices to Vacate*) are provided in our office for your review during normal business hours. You may also access the links on our website www.AngelinaCounty.net under Justice of the Peace, Civil Court page. **The Court CANNOT assist you with your case. Utilize the resources provided.**
- Forms are located on our website under Justice of the Peace, Civil Court Forms. You **must** provide the court with 1 original, 1 copy for your records, and 1 copy per defendant (*if 2 defendants will be served, then you must provide a copy for each of them*) of the petition and all documents supporting the petition.
- The Judge cannot discuss your case outside of the hearing. **Make sure you bring all evidence supporting your case to the hearing.**
- If your suit is settled out of court and you no longer wish to come to your hearing, please file it in writing with the Court. You may use the form for Non Suit located on our website.

The claim can be for no more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Eviction: An eviction case is a lawsuit brought to recover possession of real property, often by a landlord against a tenant. A claim for rent may be joined with an eviction case if the amount of rent due and unpaid is not more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.</p>	
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Repair and Remedy: A repair and remedy case is a lawsuit filed by a residential tenant under Chapter 92, Subchapter B of the Texas Property Code to enforce the landlord's duty to repair or remedy a condition materially affecting the physical health or safety of an ordinary tenant. The relief sought can be for no more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Small Claims: A small claims case is a lawsuit brought for the recovery of money damages, civil penalties, personal property, or other relief allowed by law. The claim can be for no more than \$10,000, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.</p>

WARNING: Under Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code 132.001, an unsworn declaration may be used in lieu of a written sworn declaration, verification, certification, oath, or affidavit required by statute or required by a rule, order, or requirement adopted as provided by law. This provision does not apply to a lien required to be filed with a county clerk, an instrument concerning real or personal property required to be filed with a county clerk, or an oath of office or an oath required to be taken before a specified official other than a notary public. An unsworn declaration made under this section must be 1) in writing, 2) signed by the person making the declaration as true under penalty of perjury and 3) in substantially the form used above.
