

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED REDUCTION OF SPEED LIMITS FOR CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS

Notice is here given that the Angelina County Commissioners will hold a public hearing, at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 8, 2020, at the Angelina County Commissioners Courtroom, located in the Angelina County Courthouse Annex, at 606 East Lufkin Avenue, Lufkin, Texas.

Angelina County Commissioners, at this hearing, will consider and receive public comment on a proposal to reduce the maximum legal and prudent speed limit, from thirty miles per hour to twenty miles per hour, on the following residential, county roads or streets, which are located within the Green Ridge Subdivision, a subdivision located on the west side of U.S. Highway 59 South, between the cities of Lufkin and Burke, in Precinct Number Four, in Angelina County, Texas:

1. *Green Ridge Boulevard;*
2. *Green Ridge Circle; and*
3. *Branchwood Lane.*

Angelina County Commissioners, at this hearing, will also consider and receive public comment on a proposal to reduce the maximum legal and prudent speed limit, from thirty miles per hour to twenty miles per hour, on the following residential, county road or street also located in Precinct Number Four, in Angelina County, Texas:

Walking Horse Lane, a dead end, county maintained road or street which begins at an intersection with F.M. 2108, located east of the Angelina County Airport, and then then runs in a southeasterly direction, for approximately one half of a mile, to the end of said county maintained road at the entrance to private property.

This public hearing is being held in accordance with the requirements of Section 251.152 of the Texas Transportation Code. Public input concerning the proposed traffic regulations is encouraged and welcome at this hearing.
