COURT STANDING ORDERS FILED Administrative Standing Order North 19 PM 2: 12 Justice Court, Precinct One, Angelina County, Texas

IT IS ORDERED the following shall be the Standing Order of the Court pursuant to Rule 501.2 of Who May Serve Process.

No person who is a party to or interested in the outcome of the suit may serve citation in that suit, only a sheriff or constable may serve a citation in an eviction case, a writ that requires the actual taking of possession of a person, property or thing, or process requiring that an enforcement action be physically enforced by the delivering the process. Other citations may be served only by:

- (1) A sheriff or Constable;
- (2) A process server who are currently certified under order of the Supreme Court of Texas.

NOTE: Certified processor server(s) who have been certified under the Supreme Court of Texas Order, SHALL include their identification number and expiration date on the contents of the return.

- (3) The Clerk of the Court, if the citation is served by registered or certified mail.
- (4) Only the above identified persons are approved to serve process for the Justice Court, Precinct One, Angelina County, Texas.
