You <u>must</u> provide the court with 1 original, 1 copy for your records, and 1 copy per defendant (if 2 defendants will be served, then you must provide a copy for each of them) of the petition and all documents supporting the petition.
- The Judge cannot discuss your case outside of the hearing. Please visit our website for information on how to present evidence during COVID 19 pandemic.
- The Constable does NOT serve Out of County Citations. Please notify the clerk if the Party you are suing will not be served in Angelina County.
- If your suit is settled out of court and you no longer wish to come to your hearing, please file it in writing with the Court. You may use the form for Non Suit located on our website if you wish.
