- Forms are located on our website under Justice of the Peace, Civil Court Forms. You <u>must</u> provide the court with 1 original, 1 copy for your records, and 1 copy per defendant (if 2 defendants will be served, then you must provide a copy for each of them) of the petition and all documents supporting the petition.
- The Judge cannot discuss your case outside of the hearing. <u>Make sure you bring all evidence</u> supporting your case to the hearing.
- The Constable does NOT serve Out of County Citations. Please notify the clerk if the Party you are suing will not be served in Angelina County.
- If your suit is settled out of court and you no longer wish to come to your hearing, please file it in writing with the Court. You may use the form for Non Suit located on our website if you wish.
