**REQUEST FOR DEFERRED DISPOSITION  
(Under 25)**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, Defendant, am hereby making my appearance to the Court and enter a plea of  GUILTY or  No Contest to the charge of \_\_\_\_\_ **I waive my right to a trial by jury**, and request Deferred Disposition.

As conditions of the Deferral Agreement, I understand that the Court will impose cost of court and deferral fee and final disposition will be deferred for 90 days, pending completion of all deferral terms. **\*\*NOTICE\*\*** (If full amount due is not paid within 30 days, a \$15.00 Time Payment Reimbursement Fee will be imposed)

Deferral Terms are as follows:

**Required:**

- ✓ Defendant shall not receive additional violations during the deferral period.
- ✓ Payment in Full
- ✓ All license holders under the age of 25, § 45.051, Code of Criminal Procedure, requires that you SHALL complete a Drivers Safety Course and return DSC Completion Certificate within 90 days.

**The following only apply as ordered by the Judge and indicated by check mark.**

- Defendant shall complete "Alive at 25" for Seatbelt Violations (Adult or Child) <https://aliveat25.us/> within 90 days
- As a provisional license holder, § 45.051 Code of Criminal Procedure and Section 521.161(b)(2), Transportation Code requires that you must be examined by the Texas department of Public Safety (DPS) during the deferral period. A defendant is not exempt from the examination regardless of whether the defendant was examined previously. **Take this Order to DPS with you.**
