

## NOTICE OF COUNTY'S INTENTION TO RECEIVE BIDS

Sealed bids addressed to the Commissioners Court of Angelina County, Texas will be received at the Office of Don Lymbery, Angelina County Judge (Phone No. 936-634-5413), at 102 West Frank Ave., Lufkin, Texas 75904, or at P.O. Box 908, Lufkin, TX 75902-0908, until 1:00 p.m., on Friday, January 22, 2021, for the purchase of the following described surplus property:

**All surplus furniture currently being stored in the sallyport area of the old Angelina County Jail, in its current "as is" condition and being sold as a single lot or unit.**

An original and five copies of each bid must be submitted by the bidder in a sealed envelope at the location stated above.

The submitted bids will be publicly opened and read in the Angelina County Commissioner's Courtroom, by Don Lymbery, County Judge, at 3:00 p.m., on Friday, January 22, 2021. All submitted and approved bids will then be evaluated and presented to the Angelina County Commissioner's Court for consideration in a regular session to be held on Tuesday, January 26, 2021, at 10:00 a.m.

Any person wishing to inspect the furniture or to obtain additional information should contact Don Lymbery, County Judge, Angelina County, Texas, 102 West Frank Ave., Lufkin, Texas 75904 (Phone Number: 936-634-5413).

The Commissioners Court will award the contract to the bidder deemed by the Court to serve the best interests of Angelina County. No bidder may withdraw a bid for a period of sixty (60) days following the day of the bid opening. Bidders are also advised that the bidder selected will be required to make payment in full to Angelina County within ten days of being awarded the bid and will also be required to remove the furniture from the county facility within twenty (20) days of being awarded the bid. Failure to timely pay the amount of the bid and/or to timely remove the surplus furniture in accordance with these deadlines will result in the awarded bid being rejected and cancelled. The surplus furniture, in such circumstance, will then be awarded to the remaining bid, if any, which the Court deems to be in the best interest of Angelina County.

The Commissioners Court, in accordance with Section 263.154 of the Texas Local Government Code, reserves the right to reject any offer to purchase the surplus property described above if the Court finds the rejection to be in the best interests of Angelina County, Texas. The Commissioners Court further reserves the right to waive any irregularity or informality in the bids or bidding process.
