Any such further conditions shall be announced before bidding is opened for the first sale of the day held by the Trustee or if appropriate Substitute Trustee.

Type of Sale

The sale is a nonjudicial deed-of-trust lien and security interest foreclosure sale being conducted pursuant to the power of sale granted by the Deed of Trust executed by Grantor.

The real property and personal property encumbered by the Deed of Trust will be sold at the sale in accordance with the provisions of the Deed of Trust and as permitted by section 9.604(a) of the Texas Business and Commerce Code.

Request to Act and Conduct Sale

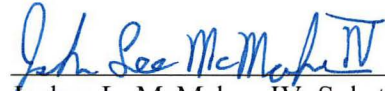

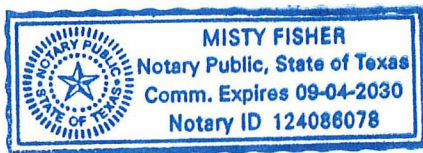

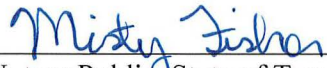
