

## Notice to Receive Bids

The Commissioners Court of Angelina County, Texas is currently accepting sealed bids for the purchase of a Feeder Bin attachment for a Pug Mill. The attachment will be utilized for the production of oil sand used in the construction, maintenance, and repair of county roads in Angelina County, Texas. Sealed bids for the purchase of this attachment will be received in the office of James McMullen, Road Administrator of Angelina County, Texas, located at 102 West Frank Avenue, Lufkin, Texas, 75901, or by mail at P.O. Box 908 Lufkin, Texas, 75902, until 12:00 PM on Friday, March 1, 2024. All sealed bids, in addition to meeting the written specifications discussed below, must also include a photo or printed picture of the attachment being submitted for consideration.

The submitted bids will be publicly opened in the Angelina County Commissioners Courtroom in the Angelina County Courthouse Annex at 606 East Lufkin Avenue, Lufkin, Texas, 75901, by James McMullen, Road Administrator of Angelina County, Texas, at 10:00 AM on Monday, March 4, 2024. All submitted and approved bids will then be evaluated and presented to the Angelina County Commissioners Court for consideration in a regular session to be held at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, March 12, 2024.

Angelina County, in accordance with the competitive bidding provisions of the County Purchasing Act, located in Chapter 262 of the Texas Local Government Code, will award the contract to the “responsible bidder who submits the lowest and best bid” as determined by the Angelina County Commissioners Court. Angelina County, in accordance with Section 262.027 of the Local Government Code, reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to publish a new notice. Angelina County further reserves the right to waive and disregard any irregularity or informality in the bids or bidding process.

Bid bonds are not required. However, no bidder may withdraw for a period of fourteen (14) days following the day of the bid opening and all bids shall be guaranteed for a period of fourteen (14) days following the bid opening. The submission of the bid in response to this invitation shall constitute an agreement of the bidder to all terms and conditions set forth in this notice and contained in the written specifications.
