

**NOTICE OF ANGELINA COUNTY'S
INTENTION TO RECEIVE BIDS**

Sealed proposals addressed to the Commissioners' Court of Angelina County, Texas, will be received at the office of the **County Commissioners, 102 West Frank Ave., Room 24, Lufkin, Texas, or mailed to P. O. Box 908, ATTN: Debbie Lewis, Lufkin, Texas, 75902** until **10:00 a.m.** on Wednesday, the 29th day of September, 2021 at which time the bids will be opened for review for the purchase of the following in accordance with the specifications now on file in the office of the County Commissioners, to wit:

All pine and hardwood located on approximately 32 acres of land located at the Angelina County Waste Management Center, located approximately 5 miles south of Loop 287 on FM 58.

Bids will be awarded at the regular Commissioners' Court meeting at 10:00 a.m. on the 12th day of October, 2021.

Such competitive bids will, at said time, be publicly opened and read before the Commissioners' Court and a contract or contracts for the purchase of such property shall be let at that time, or any time thereafter. The Commissioners' Court has determined to acquire such property in accordance with the provisions of the Public Property Finance Act, Article 2368a.2. V.A.C.S. Bidders are advised that the Public Property Finance Act authorizes the governing body of the County to enter into such contracts on such terms and conditions that are deemed appropriate by the governing body. Any bidder selected will be required to enter into contracts approved by the Commissioners' Court to evidence this obligation.

A certified/cashier's check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent of the total bid shall accompany each bid (only if the proposal is over \$25,000.00) as a guaranty that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will promptly enter into contract with the County. Bids without check or proposal will not be considered.

All prices must be stated in both script and figures. In case of ambiguity or lack of clearness in stating the price in the bids, the County reserves the right to consider the most advantageous construction thereof or to reject the bid.

All bids must be submitted on the form provided and must specify the delivery time on the items included therein.

The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids and further reserve the right to waive and disregard any irregularity or informality in the bids or bidding process and to award the contract to the bidder who, in the opinion of the Commissioners' Court, offers the proposal to the best interest of the County, and to waive formalities.
